

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



QUESTION – When will the production of the movie start?

ANSWER – The tentative start for pre-production is scheduled for May 2025, and production (i.e., principal photography) should begin by August 2025.

QUESTION – Why should I register now?

ANSWER – The film process is extensive and consists of many stages. With production just one year away and considering the number of volunteers needed, the earlier one registers, the better, especially for background acting roles. The selection process will be on a first-registered, first-picked basis.

QUESTION – Where will production take place?

ANSWER – Currently, the shooting location for the film is Northern Virginia, Fairfax County. However, there is a possibility that some scenes may be shot in Maryland and the District of Columbia.

QUESTION – Can I participate in the film's production if I live outside of the Washington Metropolitan area (DMV)?

ANSWER – Yes. Volunteers are chosen on a first-registered, first-selected basis and sometimes by experience based on the volunteer position they are interested in. Donors or those attending Church assemblies partnered with Community Flicks are given priority during the selection process. However, it doesn't matter where you live. If you are selected and able to make travel and lodging arrangements, you are welcome to register.

QUESTION – If I live outside of the Washington Metropolitan area (DMV), do I have to pay for my own travel and lodging?

ANSWER – Yes. I am afraid that due to the size of the film's budget, Community Flicks will not be able to pay for our volunteers' travel or lodging.

QUESTION – Do volunteers get paid for their participation?

ANSWER – Background actors required to be on-site for more than one day are paid a total stipend ranging between \$50 and \$100, depending on how many days they perform.

QUESTION – How often will I be needed?

ANSWER – Your schedule will depend on which volunteer position(s) you choose. If selected, you will learn more about the day(s) and time commitment(s) required during orientation.

QUESTION – Can I select more than one volunteer position?

ANSWER – Yes. However, some positions can be very demanding, so make certain you can commit to the positions you register for in case you are selected for both.
